What is the LEVIS Motorcycle Register of Australasia?

Les Thomas established the Register in 2008 with the main aim being to record the details of LEVIS motorcycles still existing in Australasia.

The Register has proven to be an effective way for owners of Levis Motorcycles to swap information and spare parts and, through that, is helping to encourage others to complete restorations and get more Levis motorcycles into fully operational condition.

Members contributions to the newsletter also help to build a record of the history of the Levis motorcycle. Members are encouraged to seek out such history by contacting and talking to ex-Levis owners and recording as much detail of their experiences as possible, especially in the sporting competition area.

The Register celebrated the Centenary of the start of Levis production in 2011 with the inaugural Gathering and Centenary Celebration in Wangaratta. The event proved a great success with 19 Levis motorcycles on display. Since then, the Register has held a Gathering every two years, with the next due in October 2021.

We are always on the lookout for Levis enthusiasts to become part of this effort. If you are an enthusiast, please consider filling in the registration form and help us keep track of these wonderful machines, it might also help you find that elusive part.
